- III. Review and Accept July meeting minutes accepted
- IV. Treasurer's Report (Deana) attached
 - a. The new membership system is allowing Deana to provide more detail about incoming payments.
 - b. Deana has created a Digital Funds Request form for reimbursements
 - i. This will also allow us to tag and track what expenses are for in order to build a predicted budget
 - c. Debit Card? Deana will inquire with the bank
 - This would be helpful for recurring costs such as the website and membership program, as well as larger purchases for events so an individual doesn't have to cover it.
- V. Membership Report (Chris)
 - a. Numbers this month are a bit unclear since everyone is getting moved over to the new system, so the date on the records may not be the actual sign up date.
 - b. 11 new signups on the website, 6 at the pool + 3 that were missed before, 3 Friends of the RCNA
- VI. MUD report MUD members are at a convention, Rachel sent report
 - a. Tamayo sidewalk project complete
 - b. No changes in facility openings, Gov. Abbott's order ties their hands with regards to occupancy limits and masking
 - i. It's unclear how the order applies to parties formally renting the facilities. The MUD lawyer is looking into this.
 - 1. If we could formally rent the facilities to impose restrictions, we may be required to carry insurance. We currently do not have any as we have been covered by the MUD's.
 - c. TexaScapes is starting to remove some dead trees from the district property.
- VII. Website report (Jeff)
 - a. Jeff needs reimbursement for membership system
 - b. Jeff has completed suggested edits for the website updates and membership system
 - c. Work for booth signup for Rattan Fest (now cancelled) will be useful for payments later
 - d. We need to transfer PayPal account ownership to be able to move PayPal accounts over to Stripe. Others (DonorBox, etc.) have been transferred successfully.
- VIII. Newsletter Report (Velisia) going well
- IX. Events Report (Chris & Jen)
 - a. 2nd Game Night recap
 - i. Went well, turnout a bit lower than the 1^{st} , 15 20 people.
 - ii. Signage strongly recommended masking for all, people generally complied.
 - iii. Austin Lonestar Services sponsored snacks

- iv. The next game night will proceed as CDC and APD recommendations suggest vaccinated folks are ok indoors if distanced and masked.
- b. July 4th parade report
 - i. Went well, folks loved the trophy. Karen Mora said she will continue to make them
 - ii. We will likely move the bike parade to our Easter event
- c. Pool party this Sunday
 - There has been much discussion about whether or not this event should happen. We are trying to balance safety concerns with providing events for our dues-paying members.
 - 1. CDC has said that community pools are low risk, and no known cases have been traced back to the Rattan Creek Pool recreation or Hurricanes practices.
 - 2. Reminder messages have strongly suggested only vaccinated persons attend. We will have signage to remind of distancing and masking recommendations.
 - 3. We can supply a box of disposable masks.
- d. Rattan Fest 9/11 cancelled
 - We didn't feel comfortable having an event geared primarily towards children and families when kids can't yet be vaccinated and the types of attractions wouldn't allow for adequate distancing.
 - ii. We didn't have the volunteer pool to run things smoothly anyway. Folks have expressed interest in volunteering generally but said they weren't ready to do this kind of event with COVID.
 - iii. Christine talked to several parties including past presidents and volunteers, longtime supporters, MUD, etc. and the general consensus is that cancelling was best.
- e. Texas Night Out, Oct 5 changes, confirmations
 - i. This will focus on community as well as first responders.
 - 1. Entertainment, food, a few yard games, etc.
 - ii. We plan to add some of the fun parts of Rattan Fest to this event.
 - iii. Because it's just for the neighborhood and also on a weeknight, numbers will be smaller and allow for distancing
- X. Potential Children's show may be a way to engage our membership safely
- XI. Holiday/Santa event in the park TBA depending on COVID numbers and vaccines for kids
- XII. Scholarships update (Alisa) two awarded
 - a. Alex Manor and Jarod Wilson each awarded \$500
 - b. Applications have been low, so we may rethink how we spend this money so it doesn't end up being a "gimme" for the few folks that apply.
 - i. We may do one scholarships at a higher amount or divert some of the funds to a community education class (such as CPR or parenting topics)
- XIII. Friends of the RCNA launched
 - a. This has revealed some misunderstanding from residents, such as that they do not have to be a homeowner to be a member
 - b. The goal is to make it known that everyone can be involved with the neighborhood and RCNA specifically
